TRAINING

Successful cadets will undergo either the Higher National Diploma or Foundation Degree route, and in some cases the Undergraduate route. All of which have specific academic programs to teach the vital information and skills required whilst at sea.

For ship board training the MNTB supply a Training Portfolio/ Training Record Book to follow and the company has devised a detailed training program for each of the above mentioned courses and will be implementing them throughout the year 2007 and onwards.

These programs are specifically designed by a qualified Officer that undertook a cadet sponsorship with the company. The benefit of having the company program, in addition to the MNTB program, is that it fills in all the gaps, questions and problems experienced by cadets whilst at sea trying to complete the mandatory requirements from the MCA.

The result is a high quality, fully completed to minimum standards Portfolio/ Training Record for submission to the MCA, that will not only look very professional and organised but will be a good source of information when undergoing the cadetship and show that the company is dedicated to training its cadets.

RECRUITMENT:

The company seeks to employ 12-15 UK cadets throughout the year with the main intakes being for September, January and May.
